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### 1.0 PURPOSE

1.1 To define the instructions required to receive and store Magnum<sup>®</sup> Board Products.

### 2.0 GENERAL

2.1 Even though Magnum Board<sup>®</sup> is virtually impervious to Fire, Water, Insects and Chemicals; does not feed Mold or Mildew; is Non-Toxic, Non-Flammable and Non-Combustible and is Very Durable, for best results we recommend that you always follow these good construction practices when taking care, custody and control of materials:

### 3.0 PROCEDURE

- 3.1 Stack flat on dun-age – do not allow material to bow, or to sit directly on the ground.
- 3.2 Keep material dry prior to and during installation
- 3.3 Do not stack other materials on top of Magnum Board<sup>®</sup>.
- 3.4 Protect Magnum Board<sup>®</sup> from jobsite dirt.
- 3.5 Protect edges, ends and faces of Magnum Board<sup>®</sup> from damage.
- 3.6 Store Magnum Board<sup>®</sup> inside and protected from damage by weather and direct sunlight whenever possible.
